Notice to: Board of Director(s) BOD's of Ten Mile Mining District (TMMD)

MMAC applauds the efforts of all members and assistants of the TMMD working towards reforming the permit conditions of dredge permits within the TMMD, and the State of Idaho. Challenging any agency regulations would not be prudent and would be safer and easier after MMAC's first federal bill passes into law. The task nonetheless is worthy of support by MMAC if certain conditions are met by the TMMD.

Over the last several months MMAC's Advisors and Administrators have noted that several board members of TMMD have sent e-mails and made verbal comments to the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) that have been less than professional and in MMAC's opinion will in fact impede TMMD's efforts in achieving favorable dredge permit conditions and impede its standing as a federally recognized governing body.

MMAC's Advisors also believe that the TMMD have not properly availed themselves to their administrative remedies with the IDWR, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) or Forest Service before taking effectively the law into their own hands, needlessly placing themselves and their membership into potential civil and criminal action by other agencies. The TMMD has also been noted as pushing new regulations and their own permits that may get challenged legally by existing agencies and MMAC is not prepared to defend TMMD's actions until there is proper oversight by MMAC's local administrator and until after MMAC's bill passes. In order that these mistakes do not continue and so positive progress is made, the following actions by the TMMD shall be required by MMAC within fourteen (14) days of this notice:

- 1) Submit signed MMAC Non-Disclosure (NCND) form from all elected TMMD board members.
 - 2) All BOD's must be MMAC Gold Members. (Ron Nielson)
 - 3) Mining District Meeting Minutes Electing To Become A MMAC Assisted Mining District and List of Members in Attendance
 - 4) TMMD Proof of Sign Posting
 - 5) TMMD board vote and meeting minutes appointing Don Smith as TMMD's sole coordinator with outside agencies such as: Forest Service, IDWR, DEQ, etc, representing TMMD on Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA) and roundtable advisor (This is to maintain TMMD in a favorable and professional position for federal recognition and future MMAC/Agency Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)).
 - 6) All BOD's of the TMMD refrain from implementing actions from other non - MMAC assisted district sources or old information, as they will most likely never achieve federal recognition as a governing body.

MMAC has asked for a conference call to remedy and fully understand the situation of the TMMD. Since no conference call has occurred:

At this point of the relationship between MMAC and TMMD. MMAC still does not recognize TMMD as a MMAC Assisted Mining District as MMACs' requirements have not been met in full. There are board members of TMMD that have their Gold MMAC Memberships revoked according to their signed MMAC Pledge. This revocation will stand until there is MMAC approved corrections allowing for a possible reinstatement. These individuals, entities and or corporations are David Hembree and David Erlanson.

The TMMD board may be able to operate with the existing TMMD BOD's or elect replacements to proceed with MMAC assistance and education. A hard copy of this letter will be going to David Hembree and David Erlanson. MMAC cannot agree with the manner the board is being lead.

If the board of the TMMD finds that the above conditions by MMAC untenable or does not provide action upon the above MMAC conditions within the above prescribed timeline, MMAC will construe a non-response as grounds that MMACs' assistance and education for the TMMD is not needed.
